


## The Process of Teaching

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1. Set a Clear Learning Objective
    - a. Clarify what will be learned; and
    - b. Specify how the learning will be demonstrated or assessed.
  2. Develop the Summative Assessment
    - a. How will students convince you that they have achieved the Clear Learning Objective?
  3. Plan and Deliver Instruction Based on the Clear Learning Objective
    - a. Anticipatory Set
    - b. Teaching and Modeling
    - c. Guided and Independent Practice
  4. Monitor and Measure Student Learning of the Clear Learning Objective
    - a. Monitor through formative assessment.
    - b. Provide intervention or enrichment based on the formative assessment.
    - c. Measure through summative assessment.
  5. Communicate Grade
    - a. A grade is as pure a measure as possible of student learning, achievement, and mastery of the Clear Learning Objective.
